Intended Use

- To remove filler residue gently.
- To degrease filled areas prior to the sealing.

Characteristics

- A mixture of special solvents matched to the König product range.

Application Notes

Recommended auxiliaries: Cloth and Felt Pad.
Stretch one layer of cloth around the felt pad, dampen cloth with Liquid Sandpaper and remove residue of Quick Filler, Soft Wax, Rex-Lith (here after 4-6 minutes hardening time) and AQUA Wood Filler from the area surrounding the damage by gently wiping.

To degrease surfaces prior to retouching/adjusting the sheen level.

Note: This product has a slight dissolving effect. We recommend to test the product on an inconspicuous area first to ensure compatibility with the surface.

(stored upright at room temperature, in unopened original container)

- Do not allow product to enter drains or watercourses.
